CANOPY RENTAL NOTES

- Pricing is for canopy rental only. Prices do not include tables or chairs.
- Canopies are installed by clients. Instructions will be provided and you will need to provide your own sledgehammer.
- It typically takes 2-3 people, 30-60 minutes to set up a canopy.
- Canopies do not have sidewalls.
- You are required to contact DigSafe to make sure there are no underground utilities present. We will provide a DigSafe brochure with instructions.
- Please let us know if you need to cook under the canopy. We have canopies that are suitable for grilling.

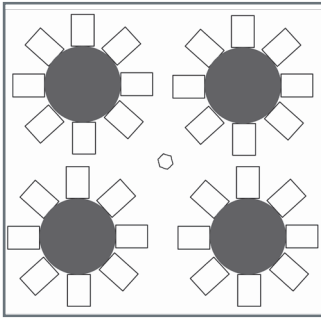

canopy instructions

MANPOWER REQUIRED

Two or three installers should be able to assemble a canopy in approximately 30-60 minutes.

TOOLS REQUIRED

Sledge Hammer

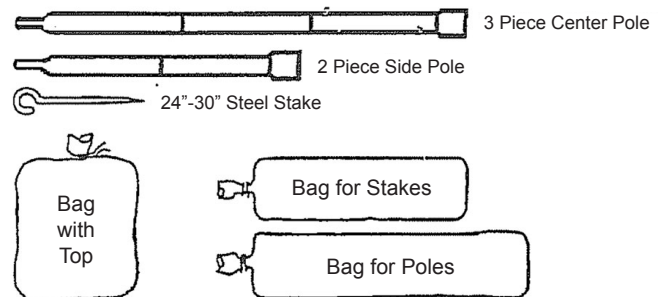
LAYOUT & CHECK

Use parts list for a quick identification and check list for proper quantities.

INSPECTION SITE CAUTION

Consult DigSafe at least 72 business hours before installation. Prior to assembly check areas for obstacles, pipes, wires, etc.

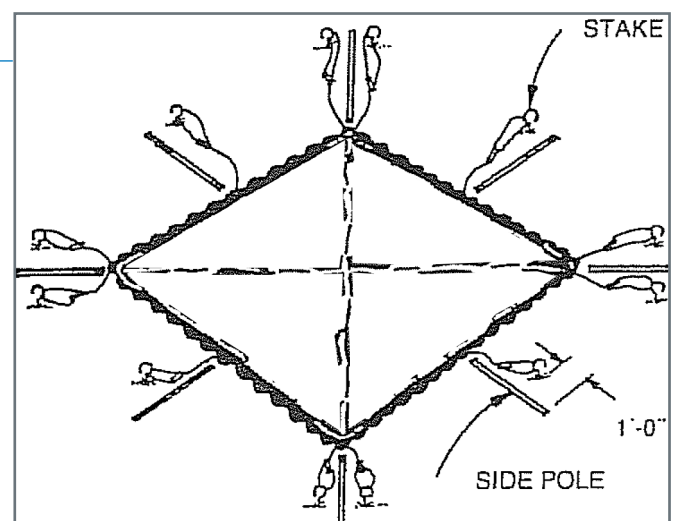

STEP ONE: LAYOUT AT SITE

A 20'x20' tent is used as example.

Spread drop clothes and unroll tent at exact position of desired finished assembly. To ensure the canopy is laid out correctly with the right side on top, look for the manufacture label which is located on the bottom side of the canopy and place this side on the ground. Any sharp objects which must remain on site under the tent should be padded and taped. Assemble side poles and lay straight out from each pole hole in tent. Drive a stake 1' from the end of each pole. Attach ropes loosely to stakes.

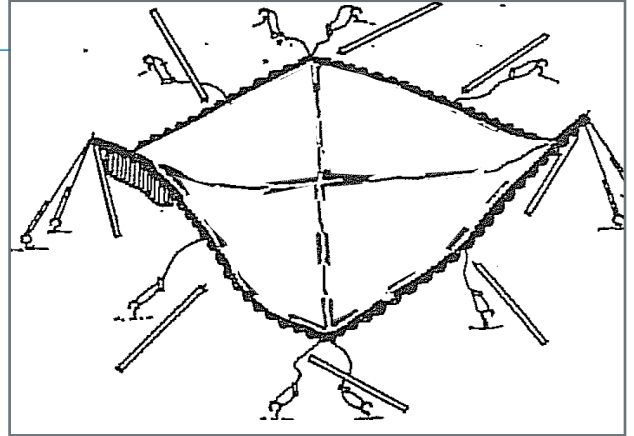


STEP TWO: RAISE SIDE POLES

Start at opposite corners.

Insert side poles into pole holes and raise so that bottom of poles slant toward center of tent.

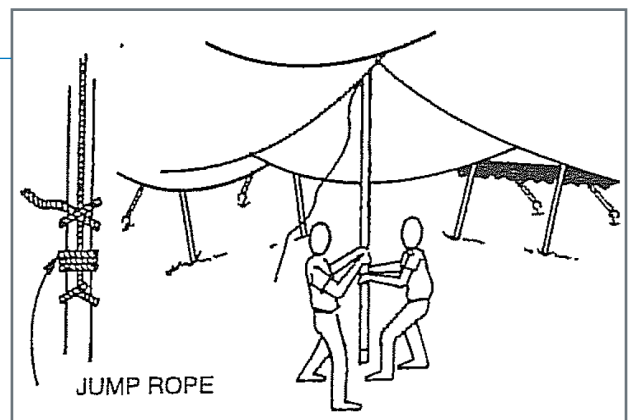
Adjust guy rope. Continue with other two corners and then sides.



STEP THREE: RAISE CENTER POLE

Assemble three piece center pole and insert into center pole hole.

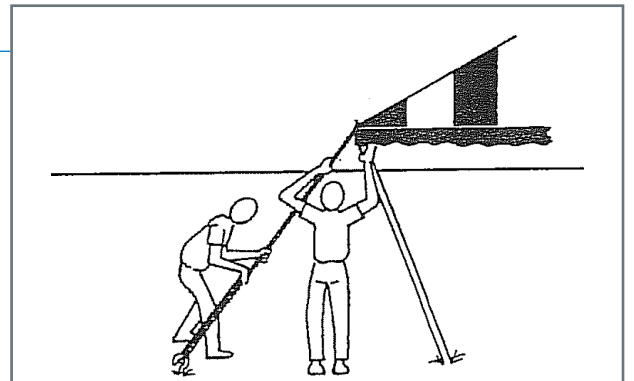
Raise to upright position and tie off jump rope to pole.



STEP FOUR: SIDE POLE ADJUSTMENT

Tighten guy ropes and then set side poles to upright position. Adjust pole positions and guy rope tension to properly pull out tent.

Protective covers are recommended for all stakes.



STEP FIVE: TAKE DOWN

Loosen all guy ropes. Spread drop cloths.

Reverse steps 1 through 4 for disassembly.

IMPORTANT:

Check Guy Ropes periodically for tightness and maintaining of good condition. Stakes provided are for average soil conditions. Sandy soil or asphalt may require additional staking. Proper installation suitable to site conditions is the responsibility of the installer.

Store tent in a cool, dry area. Never store while wet or damp.
